



### Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be learning about materials. The children will look at classifying materials according to their properties and deciding why certain materials are used for certain tasks.

As **Artists/Designers** we will be looking at how different mechanisms and lever work. They will be following instructions to make simple mechanisms that can be used in conjunction with fairytales and traditional tales. They will then have the opportunity to design their own work.

## English

### Read, Write Inc.

This term we will be covering all aspects of Literacy through the Read, Write Inc. program. The children will be learning new sounds and having regular practice at blending together the sounds that they know. There will be repetition with learning the sounds and blending as the children are encouraged to get quicker through practice. The children will be reading stories that are made up of sounds that they are familiar with. We will be learning to read with expression and using these stories to improve our comprehension skills. The children will also develop their writing skills through making changes to the stories they have learnt. On top of this, the children will have daily story time where we will be focussing on traditional and fairy tales.

## Mathematics

### Number

We will be learning how numbers are made up of tens and ones digits and using this to order and compare them.

### Shape and Space

We will be learning about position and movement using vocabulary such as half turns and left and right. The children will learn to measure using non-standard units and to make predictions about length.

## Computing

### Computer Skills

We will be learning the basic computer skills that they will need in order to be able to use a desktop or laptop computer.

We will also be learning how to log on and off and use a mouse and track pad to open and save files.

## Music

### Exploring Sound.

The children will be learning about the different types of sound and how they are made. They will learn to recognise these sounds and produce them using a range of instruments.

## British Values

### We will be focusing on The Rule of Law

We encourage children to accept responsibility for their behaviour, essential for well being and safety, and that this involves consequences when rules are broken.

## Physical Education

### Ball Games

The children will be developing their throwing and catching skills. We will also be looking at how we can control and move balls of a variety of shapes and sizes with different parts of our bodies. We will then look to apply these skills into different types of games.

## History

### Kings and Queens

The children will be learning about the role of the monarchy and some significant British monarchs. The children will learn about the chronological order of some of the monarchs and what life was like during their reign.

## SMSC

### Spiritual, moral, social and cultural awareness

We will be thinking about ourselves as learners and how we can develop.

## Religious Education

### Does Creation help people understand God?

The children will be learning about how different religions believe that the world was created. They will learn the Creation story and how this has implications for our modern day life.

## PSHE

### Personal, social and health education—Going for goals

The children will be looking at things that they want to achieve and how the choices that they make can impact on how successful they may be.
