










# All aboard! WWI and WWII Year 4T – Homework Grid – Autumn 2017

<p>Imagine you have been evacuated. <b>Write a letter</b> home to your parents.</p> <p>What would you want to tell your parents? Imagine how you would be feeling. Think about what your new home would be like and what activities you might be doing. What's your new school like?</p>	<p><b>Design and test out a parachute</b> (using a toy or a weight) that would allow a member of the RAF to land safely.</p> 	<p><b>Complete the 'Christmas Truce' reading comprehension activity.</b></p> <p>Collect a copy from me. N.B. this can be done at any time – it doesn't need to be near Christmas time!</p>	<p>Write a message to a friend or family member <b>using Morse code</b>.</p> <p><i>You can get a Morse Code information sheet from me if you would like.</i></p>	<p>Complete the <b>maths time sheet</b> (see me for a copy).</p> <p>This is best done after our lessons on time (w.b. 2<sup>nd</sup> October).</p> 	<p><b>Keep a food diary for a week.</b> Include all the food you eat during the week – breakfast, lunch, tea/dinner and any snacks.</p> <p>After half term, we will look at rationing during WWII. We will be able to compare this with what food is available now.</p>

<p><b>Design a WWII (or WWI) themed game.</b></p> 	<p>Complete the addition and subtraction <b>word problems</b> sheet. You will be given some addition and subtractions to complete. You then need to come up with a word problem that fits the number sentence. Collect a sheet from me.</p> <p>This is best done after 20<sup>th</sup> October.</p>	<p>Sometimes the class is lucky and they have someone new to the school (child or adult). Your challenge is <b>to make a welcome pack</b> that can be given to help any new person joining the school.</p> <p>See me for a list of things to include in the welcome pack.</p>	<p>Complete the <b>addition and subtraction</b> sheet. See me for a copy.</p> <p>This is best done after 20<sup>th</sup> October.</p> 	<p><b>Research the Jewish faith.</b> Write 10 facts about it.</p> 	<p><b>Write a newspaper report.</b> This can either be about a significant event during WWI or WWII, or you can do a newspaper report about a recent event in your life, e.g. a football match you played in or a gymnastics competition.</p> <p>This is best done after half term, when we will be looking at newspaper reports in English.</p>

You can do this in a method of your choice, such as a poster, a biography or a computer presentation.</p>	<p><b>Research old British currency and write some WWII maths money problems.</b></p>
