Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be exploring animal bodies. The children will be learning about the different parts of the body and how they work.

As **Geographers** we will be exploring our school environment with all its different areas.

As **Artists/Designers** we will be looking at mixing and blending colours and how we can use this in our own work.

English

Reading

We will be listening to lots of stories and looking at the repetitions and patterns that appear in the stories. We will also be looking at predicting what we think will happen in stories. For non-fiction the children will be learning about non-chronological texts.

Writing

We will continue learning about writing sentences, embedding what the children already know and learning how to extend a sentence.

Spelling and Grammar

We will continue to learn new sounds and blend them together to read whole words. We will be applying the rules we know to spell simple words. The children will be learning to how to write question sentences

Mathematics

Number

We will be learning how numbers are made up of tens and ones digits and using this to order and compare them.

Shape and Space

We will be learning about position and movement using vocabulary such as half turns and left and right. The children will learn to measure using non-standard units and to make predictions about length.

Computing

Computer Skills

We will be learning the basic computer skills that they will need in order to be able to use a desktop or laptop computer.

We will also be learning how to log on and off and use a mouse and track pad to open and save files.

Music

Sound sources.

The children will be learning about the different places that sounds come from and how this changes the sound made.

British Values

We will be focusing on The Rule of Law

We encourage children to accept responsibility for their behaviour, essential for well being and safety, and that this involves consequences when rules are broken.

Physical Education

Playground and Team Games

The children will learn a variety of Playground Games that can be enjoyed at playtime. For indoor PE, the children will be learning simple gymnastics moves that can be put together into a sequence.

History

Great Explorers

The children will be learning about explorers such as Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong and Robert Falcon Scott. They will learn about the chronology of time and the similarities in the explorers.

SMSC

Spiritual, moral, social and cultural awareness— Tolerance

We will be discussing what tolerance means, why it is important and how we can show it.

Religious Education

The children will be learning about the Christian and Jewish festivals of Christmas and Sukhot. The children will learn that festivals are giving thanks for things and is a shared human experience
