











Oxford, Alice in Wonderland, Vikings 4T - Homework Grid – Spring 2018

This could be someone born in Oxford, who went to University in Oxford, or who has some other link to Oxford. You could present this using a computer or write it in your homework book.</p> <p>Some examples are Lewis Carroll, Philip Pullman, JRR Tolkien, Tim Henman, CS Lewis, Hugh Laurie.</p>	<p>Write a short story involving Vikings. It's up to you which direction you want to take this in!</p> 	<p>French homework.
