Into the woods!



Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will explore

As **Historians** we will be learning about the lives of Christopher Columbus and Pocahontas and exploring the Native American culture.

As **Geographers** we will be comparing the UK and the USA and looking specifically at the comparison between habitats and famous landmarks.

As **Artists** we will be studying Native American animal art and focusing on animals found in both American an British woodland.

In **DT** we will be designing our own finger puppets focusing on characters from Traditional Tales.

English

Reading

We will be reading a selection of Traditional Tales.

Writing

We will write our own version of Little Red Riding Hood.

Spelling and Grammar

We will be recapping work on nouns, adjectives and verbs and using these effectively in writing sentences. We will also be investigating plurals and contractions and the difference between statements, commands and questions.

Mathematics

Number

We will be developing our place value knowledge, counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's and our understanding of money.

Shape and Space

We will be investigating and sorting 3D shapes by their properties such as the number of faces, vertices and edges.

Computing

We are astronauts

We will be developing our skills as we learn to program a sprite to move around a screen, by giving it different instructions. We will learn how to follow and plan instructions, before generating our own.

Physical Education

Indoor PE

The children will participating in Gymnastics, allowing the children to extend their agility, balance and coordination.

Outdoor PE

The children will focus on their control of using a ball. They will learn to dribble, pass and apply these in team games.

Religious Education
