

Literacy

I will be:

- learning to recognise and write my name.
- learning different sounds that letters make (phonics).
- learning to write familiar words such as mum, dad.
- writing about my family.
- learning to write for a purpose e.g. making lists, labelling pictures.
- re-telling stories.
- talking about characters in story books.
- labelling my body parts.

Mathematics

I will be:

- learning to count, recognise and order numbers to at least 10.
- learning to match numbers to quantities of groups to at least 10.
- learning to relate addition to combining two or more groups of objects.
- learning about patterns.
- learning about the days of the week.

Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural

I will be:

- learning to think about the feelings of others.

Communication & Language

I will be:

- taking part in circle time.
- talking about my family and myself.
- listening to stories and rhymes.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

I will be:

- learning to participate in turn taking games.
- trying out new activities and selecting resources independently.
- dressing and undressing independently for PE.
- learning routines of the school day.
- learning and talking about my family and other people who are important to me.

Expressive Arts & Design

I will be:

- drawing a picture of myself using mirrors.
- drawing a picture of my family.
- learning new songs to help me in my learning.
- using role play in the home corner and doctor's surgery.
- using a range of materials to make collages and models.

Physical Development

I will be:

- learning to travel in a variety of ways.
- exploring movements with my body.
- learning to move with control and co-ordination over, under and through various large apparatus.
- learning to move with confidence, control and safety.
- developing my hand control.
- learning about a healthy lifestyle.
- using a range of tools safely.
- using a range of malleable materials in my play.

Understanding the World

I will be:

- talking about similarities and differences between my friends and my family.
- using digital cameras to take photos of my friends.
- using my five senses to investigate the area around me.
- finding out about the different parts of my body.
- finding out how I have changed as I have grown up.

Religious Education

I will be:
