



Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be looking at sound, identifying how sounds are made and travel. We will also explore pitch and volume as well as the ear and how it works.

As **Artists/Designers** we will be looking at art inspired by music. We will also look at how instruments are made and how they effectively create sound.

English

Reading

We will be looking at different newspaper articles, before exploring some poetry on the theme of diversity.

Writing

We will be writing our own newspaper articles, looking at how these are structured and how this differs from stories. We will write our own poems.

Spelling and Grammar

We will have a weekly spelling lesson and cover aspects of grammar in our English lessons. This will include looking at fronted adverbials and speech punctuation this term.

Mathematics

Number

We will be working on fractions, including comparing fractions and finding equivalent fractions. We will introduce decimal numbers, and how these link with fractions and whole numbers. We will continue working on written methods for arithmetic.

Shape and Space

We will be looking at measures this term, focusing on weighing using scales and measuring capacity. We will look at drawing and interpreting bar charts.

Computing

We are musicians

We will be creating music using different software before editing and sharing it.

Music

We will be exploring lots of different music, including from different traditions and cultures. We will also improvise, compose and perform music for different purposes.

British Values

We will be focusing on Tolerance of different faiths and beliefs

Our school value this term is **Tolerance** and we will explore this in assemblies as well as linking it in with our everyday class work, particularly in PSHE.

Physical Education

Netball and Gymnastics

Indoor PE this term is gymnastics.

Outdoor PE this term is netball.

PE will be on **Mondays** (indoor) and **Wednesdays** (outdoor).

French

My Home

This term in French, Miss B will be covering vocabulary related to the home. We will be learning to talk about different rooms in the house and what you might find in them.

This will be linked to RE and our school values. This term our school value is **Tolerance**.

Religious Education
