Most subjects this term will be linked to this topic, we aim to have a fun and exciting term where the children enjoy their learning and thrive.

## Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be looking at animals and humans; what they need to survive the body.

As **Geographers** we will be focusing on food miles and fair trade.

As **Artists** we will be studying packaging and chocolate.

As **Historians** we will be looking at significant individuals such as James Lind.

## English

**Reading** - Our class story is Charlie and the Chocolate Family by Roald Dahl. It is a great book and we will be following the journey of Charlie throughout the term and carrying out some guided reading tasks. We are hoping to have a celebration at the end of the term and watch the 2005 version of the film.

**Writing** - This term we will be looking at the features of and writing a range of text types. The children will write their own newspaper reports and instructions that will all link in with our topic.

**Spelling and Grammar** - SPaG will be a focus within our English lessons as well as a stand alone lesson each week. Each Friday, the new spelling rule will be taught before spellings are given out so the children will have a good understanding of the spelling rule.

A weekly test will take place on a Friday, so it would be really helpful if the children could learn them at home.

## Mathematics

### Number

We will work on place value of large numbers, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; and fractions .

### Shape and space

The children be focusing on telling the time with increasing accuracy and identifying, describing and sorting 3D shapes.

## Computing

This term the children will be focusing on the using the internet. Children will learn about the history of the World Wide Web (WWW), how it works.

We will look at:

- Google searching
- Communication
- Privacy and Safety

## Music

This term the children will have the opportunity to learn how to play a musical instrument. The very talented Mrs Lloyd will be teaching weekly violin/cello lessons - more information will be sent out advising you on taking the instruments home.

## Physical Education
