## English

### Reading

We will be reading *Stormbreaker* by Anthony Horowitz : a spy thriller this term.

We will be focusing on different types of questions within a range of comprehensions. To make sure we are fully prepared for the SATs.

### Writing

We will be writing newspaper reports and persuasive texts.

### Spelling and Grammar

Within all our literacy work we will be teaching spelling, punctuation and grammar. This will also be taught as an independent activity throughout the year with a big focus on spelling. Children will get spellings weekly to learn at home.

## Mathematics

### Number

We will be doing a weekly arithmetic test, which covers all the four maths operations, percentages, fractions and decimals.

In daily maths lessons we will be calculating the mean average, using the four operations to solve word problems, finding the nth term, ratios and algebra.

### Shape, measurement

In daily maths lessons we will be learning about: line graphs, pie charts, co-ordinates, reflections, finding unknown angles around a point, on a line and in shapes;

## Computing

We will be looking at coding programmes, and writing algorithms.



## Design and Technology

We will be designing our own newspaper header for our class newspaper.

We will design a digital classroom of the future.



## History

We will be looking at the history of computing.



## Physical Education

In PE we will be playing table tennis.



## PSHE

We will be looking at how to be safe on the internet.

Look at how robots replace people in certain jobs.



## Art

We will be looking at Logos and designing our own.



## Religious Education

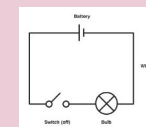
