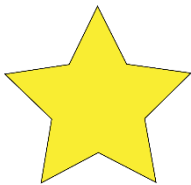

Breakfast Club and After School Club

Once a year we also need to practise the systems for locking down the school which we plan to do towards the end of next week.

Lockdown procedures could happen in any number of situations, each of which would necessitate a different response but generally pupils and staff return to their classrooms and close their doors and windows and await further instructions.

A lockdown is a precaution aimed to keep children and staff safe while remaining indoors. This may be as a result of a reported incident/civil disturbance in the local community with the potential to pose a risk to children and staff or a warning being received regarding the risk of air pollution, or a dangerous animal in the vicinity. I just thought it would be a good idea to warn you so that you don't worry when your children come home talking about a school lockdown!
