Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be using our observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions about the human body and our senses.

As **Historians** we will be learning about changes within living memory. Compare our own life and interests now with our babyhood (e.g. clothes, toys, food, size and abilities), recall a significant memory from the past.

As **Artists** we will be using a range of materials creatively to design and make products.

English

Read Write Inc.

The children will take part in Read, Write Inc. lessons four times a week. This focuses on learning and blending sounds, whole word and whole text reading and writing sentences.

Talk for Writing.

Throughout the term the children will be learning a story, re-telling it and using this to produce their own writing. We will also be listening to and reading a range of stories to develop the children story writing vocabulary.

Handwriting:

We practice handwriting and letter formation daily in Year 1.

Mathematics

Number: Place value

Add and subtract one digit numbers to 10, including zero.

Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representation and missing number problems.

Count, read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words.

The Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representation including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.

Computing

We will be using a word processing programme to learn how to use a keyboard and a mouse. Learn how to change the font, font colour and size.

Physical Education

We will be learning about ball skills. How to roll, throw and catch a ball and use these skills to play simple team games.

Religious Education

We will be exploring and comparing reasons for celebrating Harvest and Christmas and learning that not everyone celebrates the same festivals.

Music

We will be using our voices expressively and creatively learning songs for our Christmas production.

Geography

We will use the correct terms for simple geographical features in the local environment.

PSHE

Personal, social and health education.

We will learn about what can go into bodies and how it can make people feel.

We aim to promote this value by demonstrating how democracy works by discussion, decision making and voting.
