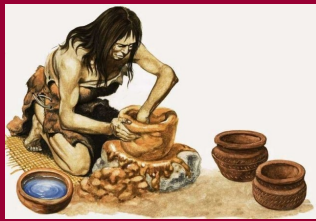


Year 3 Term 2

Tribal Tales



Most subjects this term will be linked to this topic, we aim to have a fun and exciting term where the children enjoy their learning and thrive.

Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be looking at rocks and fossils.

As **Geographers** we will be focusing on existing Stone Age monuments around the UK.

As **Artists** we will be studying cave art, stone engraving and Stone Age tools.

As **Historians** we will be looking at Prehistoric Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

English

Reading - We will be using a number of texts this term. All books will be linked to our topic:

How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth, Stone Age Boy and Stig of the Dump.

Writing - This term we will be looking instructional writing, fictional writing and poetry.

Spelling and Grammar - Our weekly spellings will be based on phonics. We are going to be looking at all the alternative ways to make the same sound. As well as this, we will be adding some of the common exception words from previous years to the weekly word lists. Grammar will be taught through our English lessons and embedded in our daily lessons.

A **weekly test will take place on a Friday**, so it would be really helpful if the children could learn them at home.

Mathematics

This term we are continuing to follow the White Rose scheme of work.

We will work on:

- Subtraction
- Multiplication
- Division

Computing

This term the children will be focusing on coding.

We will look at:

- Programming sequences
- Creating simple animations
- Design and debug

Music

This term we will be following a scheme of work from the Charanga programme.

We will also be spending time practising for the Christmas concert—more details to follow regarding this.

British Values
