Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be learning about the digestive system, including looking at different types of teeth and how to look after them.

As **Artists/Designers** we will design and make our own 3D hats for our Mad Hatter's tea party.

English

Reading

We will be looking at the story of *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*.

Writing

We will be looking at persuasive writing in the form of letters. Later in the term we will look at character descriptions.

Spelling and Grammar

We will have a weekly spelling lesson and cover aspects of grammar in our English lessons. This will include looking at expanded noun phrases and word classes this term.

Mathematics

We will finish looking at multiplying and dividing numbers by 10 or 100. This will lead us on nicely to multiplying larger numbers, working towards using short multiplication.

Later in the term we will return to division and look at dividing larger numbers, working towards using short division.

We will then look at area and perimeter towards the end of the term.

Computing

Coding — variables

We will be coding this term. We will learn how computers use variables to count things and keep track of what is going on, then create games which use a score variable.

Music

We will be working with Christ Church Cathedral again this term, building up to a performance after half term.

We will look at the choices we make, linking in with our school value for the term of honesty and our PSHE work focusing on ourselves and our individual qualities.
