Key Areas of Learning

CRASH! What's that in the playground? Let's go and take a look. Stand back everyone—it looks like a UFO has crash-landed!

English

Read Write Inc.

The children will take part in Read, Write Inc. lessons five times a week. This focuses on learning and blending sounds, whole word and whole text reading and writing sentences.

Talk for Writing.

Throughout the term, the children will be learning a story, re-telling it and using this to produce their own writing.

Handwriting:

We practice handwriting and letter formation daily in Year 1.

Grammar:

We will be learning to Proof read (check for mistakes) and edit (make our writing better).

Mathematics

Number: Addition and Subtraction within 20

Represent and use number bonds within 20

Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.

Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, and missing number problems such as $7 = \square - 9$

Number: Place Value within 50

Count, read and write numbers to 50 in numerals.

Given a number, identify one more or one less.

Number: Multiples of 2, 5 and 10

Count and write multiples of 2, 5 and 10

Computing

The children will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

Physical Education

The children will perform dances using simple movement patterns.

Religious Education

The children will be to explore the significance and role of places of worship. Churches, synagogues, temples and more.

Music

The children will experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using a variety of instruments.

Geography

The children will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key physical factors, including : beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil and valley.

PSHE

Personal, social and health education.

We will work with the children to help them realise that people and other living things have needs, and that they have responsibilities to meet them.

British Values

This topic will cover democracy, Rule Of Law, Individual liberty, tolerance and respect.

Spiritual, moral, social and cultural awareness
