

Year 2 Term 3



Muck, Mess and Mixtures

Most subjects this term will be linked to this topic, we aim to have a fun and exciting term where the children enjoy their learning and thrive.

Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be gathering information, performing fair tests and using this information to answer questions.

As **Artists** we will be focusing on the artists Kandinsky and Carl Warner.

In D.T we will be tasting foods from around the world, discussing the basic principles of a varied and healthy diet as well as prepare dishes.

English

We will be reading George's Marvellous Medicine and Room on the broom. We will be using these books to learn about how to write instructions and to write part of a story in a familiar pattern.

Spelling and Grammar - This term we will be looking at suffixes: 'ing' and 'ed'. The children will be learning how to use expanded noun phrases, imperative verbs and subordination in their writing.

This term we are learning how to join our letters using the continuous cursive style.

Each Friday, the children will be learning new spelling patterns which then will be tested the following Friday.

The children will have the opportunity to change their reading book every day. We would recommend that you listen to your child read for five minutes every day.

Mathematics

Will be teaching for mastery this term and will be following the White Rose scheme of work.

We will work on:

- Multiplication and Division.
- Properties of shapes.
- Tally Charts, Pictograms and Block Diagrams.

Computing

This term the children will use coding to learn that one object can be used to control another object. The children will be writing their own codes.

Music

The children will be learning to create rhymical, musical patterns.

British Values
