



Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be learning about living things and how they can be grouped and sorted in different ways. We will also be learning about food chains, and what would happen if one part of the food chain became 'unavailable'.

As **Artists/Designers** we will be looking at and creating our own ocean inspired art. We will use a range of different materials such as clay and (appropriately) watercolours.

English

Reading

We will be looking at *No Dinner! The Story of the Old Woman and the Pumpkin*.

Writing

We will be looking at fiction writing, focusing on journey stories. Later in the term we will look at poetry.

Spelling and Grammar

We will have a weekly spelling lesson and cover aspects of grammar in our English lessons. This will include looking at fronted adverbials, apostrophes and speech punctuation this term.

Mathematics

We will be looking at fractions this term, mastering an understanding of what a fraction represents. We will compare fractions, looking at both unit fractions and non-unit fractions. We will also look at adding and subtracting fractions, and finding fractions of numbers.

Later in the term, we will look at decimal numbers and how these relate to our previous work on place value and whole numbers.

Computing

Coding—repetition and loops

We will be coding this term. We will learn how computers use repetition and loops to make algorithms more efficient.

Music

We will be continuing our work with Christ Church, building up to our performance in Christ Church Cathedral on Wednesday 18th March at 11:00am.
