Superheroes



Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be looking at 'the human body and senses, eating healthily and beginning to answer questions scientifically.

As **Artists** we will be drawing and modelling superheroes.

As **Designers** we will be making superhero masks. The children will also look at super foods and describe and classify them.

English

Read

Write Inc.

The children will take part in Read, Write Inc. lessons five times a week. This focuses on learning and blending sounds, whole word and whole text reading and writing sentences.

Talk for Writing.

Throughout the term, the children will be learning a story, re-telling it and using this to produce their own writing.

Handwriting:

We practice handwriting and letter formation daily in Year 1.

Grammar:

We will be learning the basic tools of writing.

Mathematics

Place Value within 10

The children will:

- Count, read and write numbers within 10 forwards and backwards;
- Give a number, identifying one more and one less;
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations;
- Use language such as more than, less than, equal to, fewer, least, most.

Addition and subtractions within 10

The children will:

- Represent and use number bonds within 10;
- Add and subtract one digit numbers to 10, including 0
- Solve one step problems using + and -.

Computing

The children be looking at videos and thinking about e-safety. They will also be learning how to copy and download safely images from the internet.

Physical Education

Superhero Movements

The children will be combining a series of balances to create a sequence of events about a superhero. The children will be working on their balance, agility and co-ordination.

Religious Education

The children will be exploring how different religions celebrate special people.

Music

The children will learn to follow a beat and create their own. They will also change the pace and volume of the beat.

History

The children will be learning about heroes and heroines from history.

PSHE

Personal, social and health education

The children will be learning about good and bad choices, keeping safe and making a positive contribution.

British Values

The Superhero topic will cover democracy, rule of law, individual liberty, tolerance and respect.

SMSC

Spiritual, moral, social and cultural awareness
