Predators

Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will be looking at the human body. We will look at bone, joints, muscles as well as diet and food chains

As **Geographers** we will be focusing on different habitats and climates that Predators have adapted to.

As **Artists** we will be focusing on 3D models using natural resources.

English

Spelling and Grammar - SPaG will be a focus within our English lessons as well as some stand alone lesson each week. Each Friday, the new spellings will be sent home. We will begin to move onto Spelling Rules as we have nearly completed our phonics review.

A weekly test will take place on a Friday, so it would be really helpful if the children could learn them at home.

We will work on:

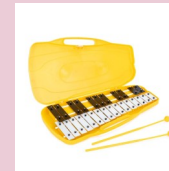
- Length
