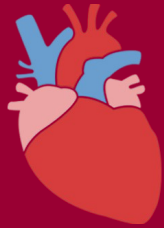


Year 6 Term 4

# Blood Heart



Find out how to keep your heart happy.

We will be linking a lot of our work this term to the Blood Heart topic; with a big focus on Science.

Our maths and English will link to our topic, but there will also be stand alone activities to prepare the children for the pending SATs in May.

## English

### Reading

We will be reading Pig Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman this term.

We will be focusing on different types of questions within a range of comprehensions. We will do weekly guided reading sessions and look at a range of past SATs reading papers.

### Writing

We will be writing a persuasive text about using a pig's heart for human transplant and discuss the different views about this. We will look at poetry and adverts.

### Spelling and Grammar

Within all our literacy work we will be teaching spelling, punctuation and grammar. This will also be taught as an independent activity throughout the year with a big focus on spelling. Children will get spellings weekly to learn at home.

## Mathematics

We will be doing a weekly arithmetic test, which covers all the four maths operations, percentages, fractions and decimals.



In daily maths lessons we will be learning about: metric and imperial measurements; perimeter, area and volume; and ratio.

## Computing

Looking at flow diagrams in relation to the heart.

Designing and producing a film about keeping a healthy lifestyle.

## DT

We will be creating a heart out of wire and Modroc. We will be learning how to make a quick healthy meal.



## PSHE

We will be looking at how to keep ourselves healthy.



## Physical Education

In PE we will be continuing to do orienteering, outdoor adventure, solving problems in groups and taking part in a class table tennis competition.



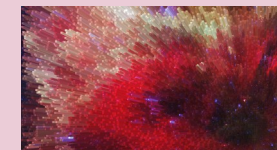
## French

We will be looking at and creating abstract art.



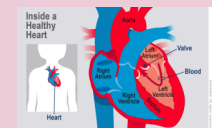
## Religious Education
