

Mrs Barnard's Group - Week 5 I can make a sentence

I have included this sentence work by popular demand. Your child will need a pencil, scissors and, ideally, glue.

From Monday to Thursday, in addition to practising the week's words using the look, cover, write, check method, the children unscramble words to create a sentence (which includes one of the week's words) and practise writing it.

On Friday it is dictation time! Please read the sentences, one at a time, and ask your child to write them down, remembering to start each one with a capital letter and finish it with a full stop (which might sometimes take the form of a question mark).

Read each sentence three times. Once for your child to simply listen, once when they are writing, and once for them to check when they have finished writing. Then move on to the next sentence.

1. They went to the park on Sunday.
2. Their bags were on the hook.
3. Is there fish and chips on Friday?
4. The frog jumped over here.

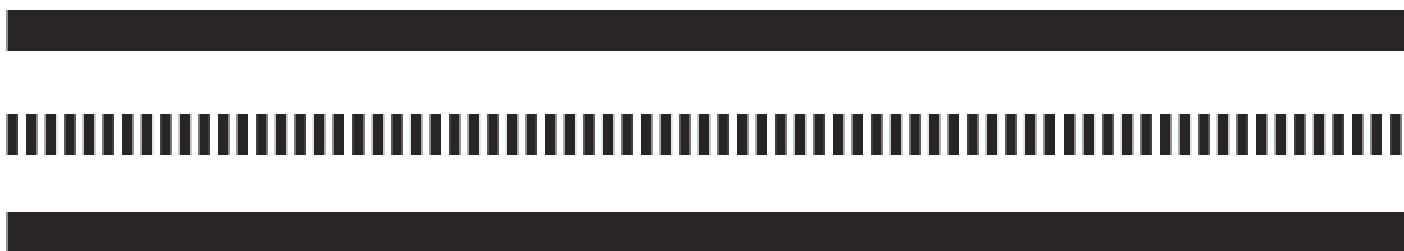
