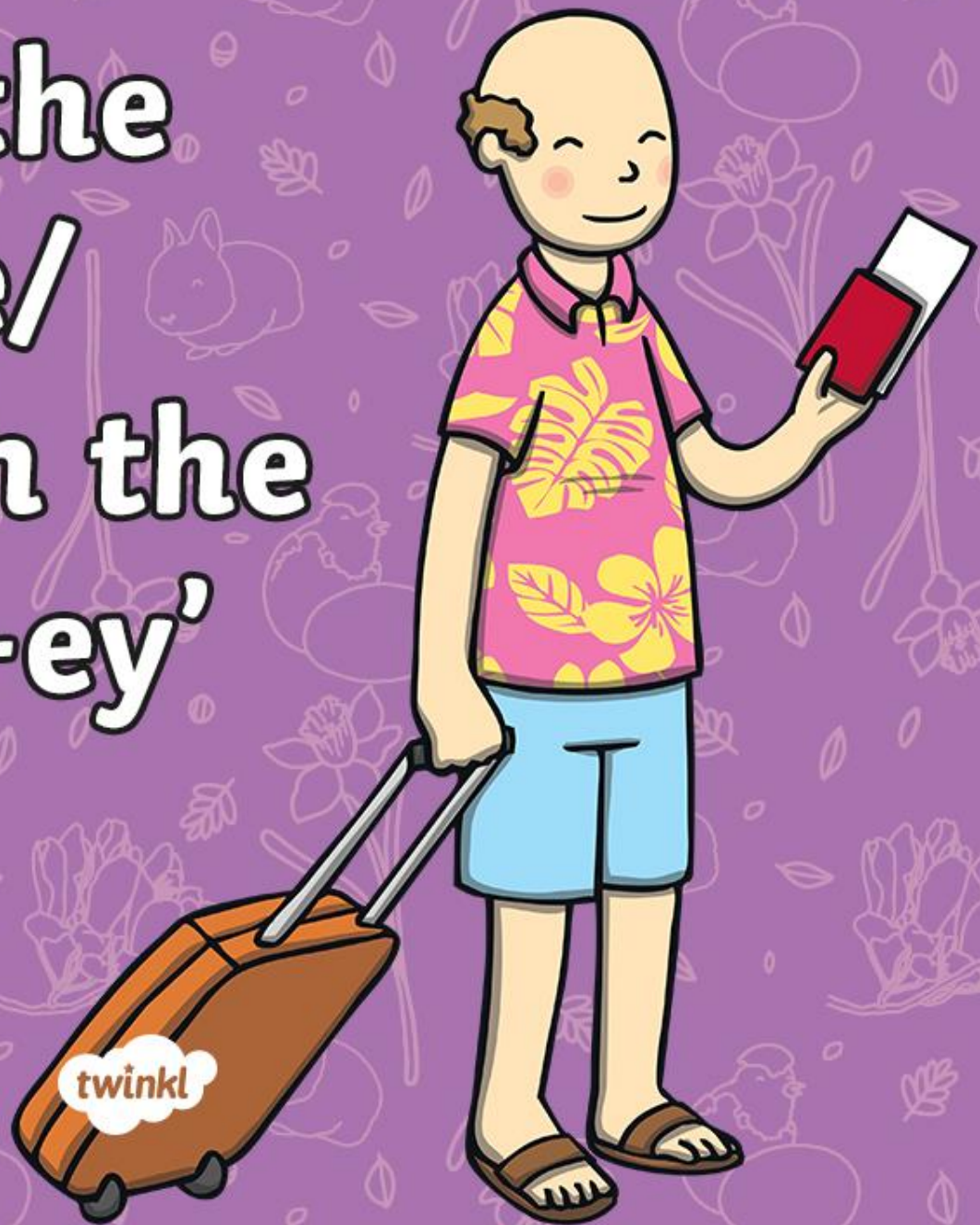

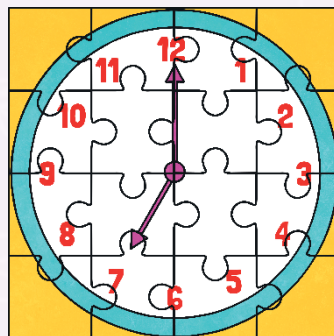

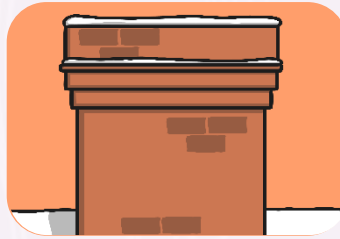

The vowel digraph 'ey' can be used to spell the /ee/ sound at the end of words.

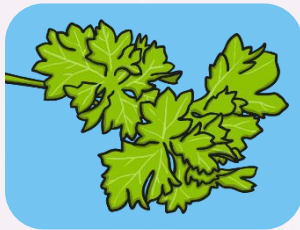
The vowel digraph 'ey' can be used to spell the /ee/ sound at the start of words.



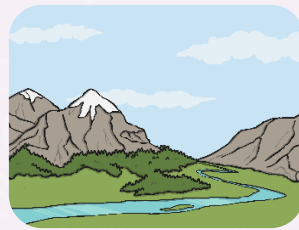

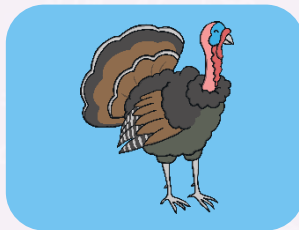


A large container on wheels, used to put your shopping in.
