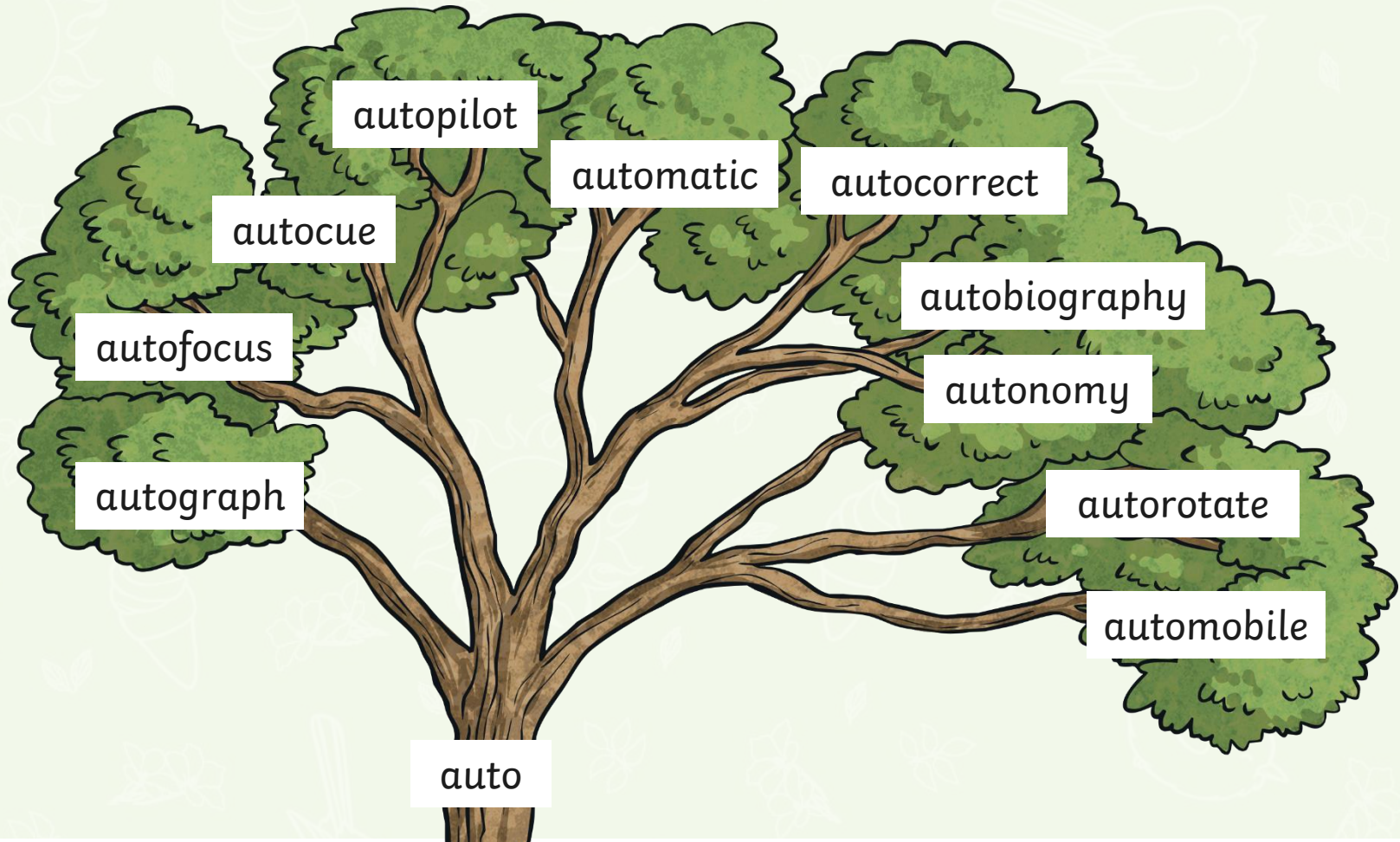
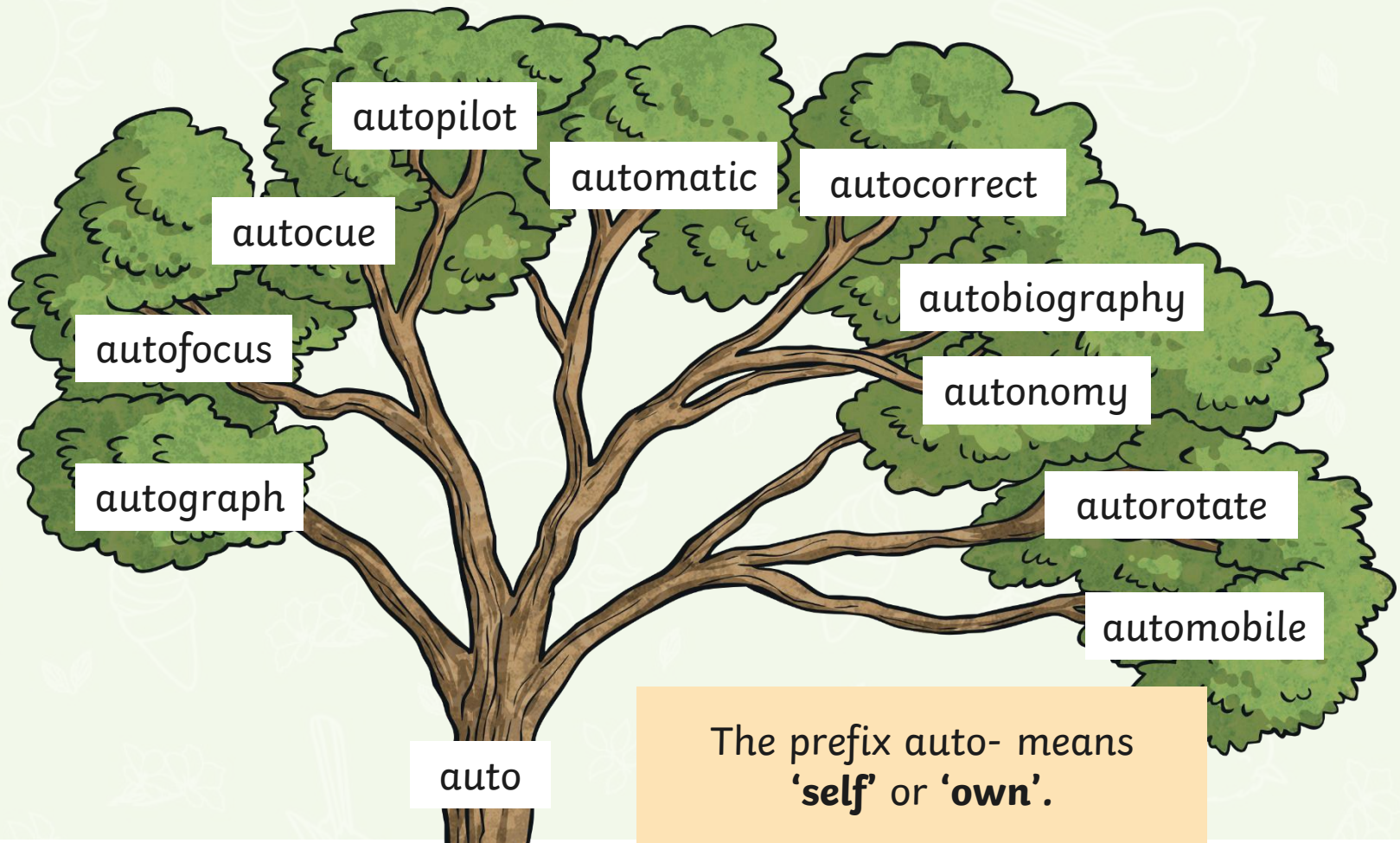


This week, we are going to look at adding the prefix **auto-** to words.
