Start the sentence **I can see** **archery, judo**, and remember to use a **comma** to separate all the sports in your list. Then use **and** between the last two sports in your list.

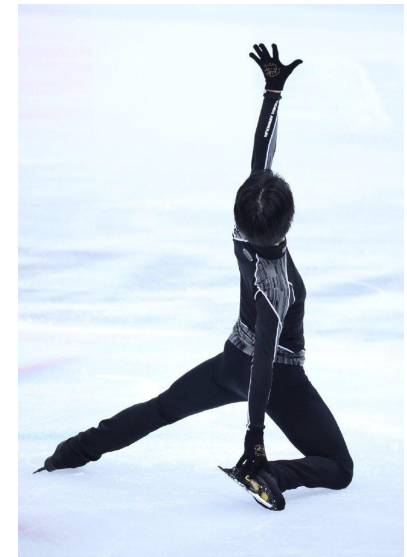
