We have had another busy week in school.

Our theme this week has been Sports. We have looked at the Olympics, finding out about how they started and which sports take place. We looked at clips of Olympic events including sprinting, diving, swimming, gymnastics, long jump and high jump.. We designed our own medals and won medals during our sports events.

We held our own races and sports events. We enjoyed using the tracks to race on and we used the timers to time other children. Our events included running, skipping, hopping, throwing bean bags into hoops, and bouncing and dribbling balls in and out of cones. Exhausting!
