<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>As writers, we will be writing quest myths and writing persuasive letters.</p> <p>We will be reading a selection of Greek Myths including The Quest of Perseus and then Jason and the Golden Fleece.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>As mathematicians, we will be learning about statistics – looking at pictograms, bar charts and tables. We will then be looking at measurements: length and perimeter. To finish the term, we will start to look at fractions. Our work on fractions will continue after Easter.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PE</b></p> <p>In PE, we would usually be doing athletics, but this term, if possible, we will be doing basketball and cricket (as we missed these last term).</p>

The children will have the opportunity to learn about the different gods and goddesses and find out about what life was like for the ancient Greeks. This will be supported by a trip to the Ashmolean Museum in Oxford, where the children will encounter ancient ceramics which tell fascinating tales.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Music</b></p> <p>As musicians we will continue to develop our singing voices and will recap our understanding of the glockenspiel when we are back in school.</p>
