<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>As writers, we will initially be looking at fiction writing and journey stories. We will use the book, <i>No Dinner! The Story of the Old Woman and the Pumpkin</i>. Later in the term, we will be looking at persuasive speeches.</p> <p>In guided reading we will be looking at <i>The Song of the Dolphin Boy</i> by Elizabeth Laird.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>As mathematicians, we will continue to follow the White Rose scheme of work.</p> <p>We will be looking at fractions, continuing to solidify an understanding of what a fraction represents. We will compare fractions, looking at both unit fractions and non-unit fractions. We will also look at adding and subtracting fractions, and finding fractions of numbers.</p> <p>Later in the term, we will look at decimal numbers and how these relate to our previous work on place value and whole numbers.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>In PE, we will be doing yoga for indoor PE and athletics for outdoor PE.</p> <p>Wednesday will be indoor PE and Thursday will be outdoor PE.</p>

We will learn how computers use repetition and loops to make algorithms more efficient.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Term 4 – Blue Abyss</p> <p>In this topic, our focus will be on the oceans. We will also be learning about food chains, and what would happen if one part of the food chain became 'unavailable'.</p>
