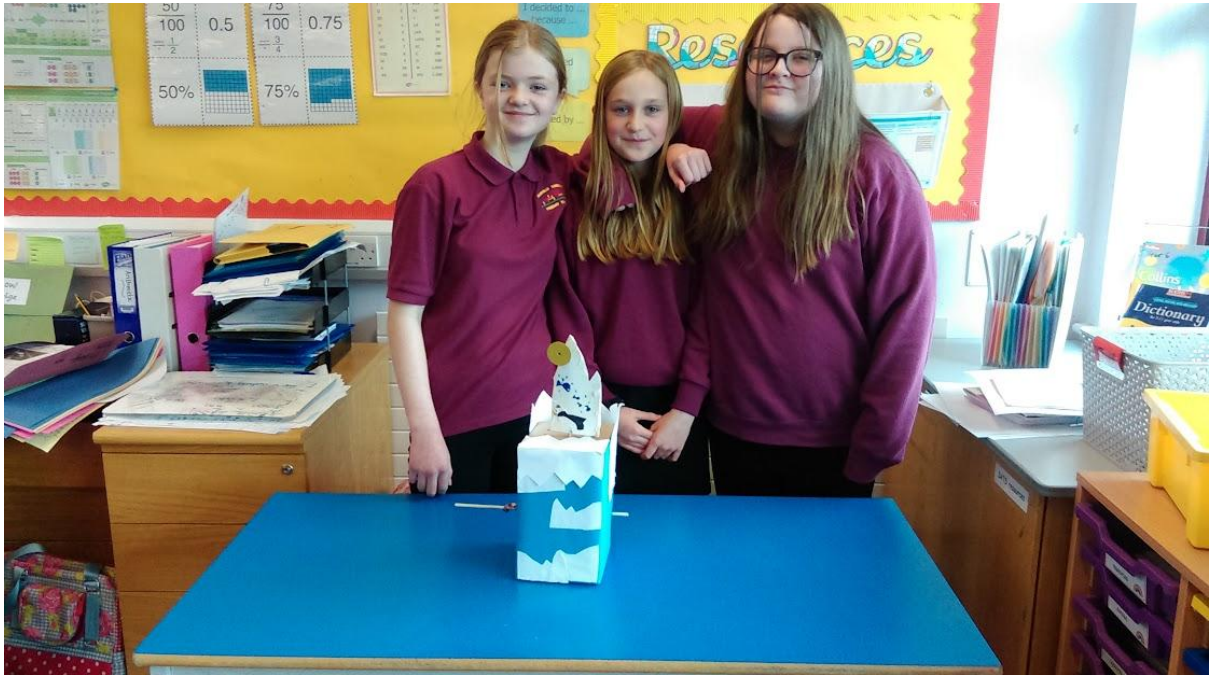


Year Six Cam Toys

The interior of the cam toy will have a cam and a

follower. The cam is a piece of wood that can be an egg shape or a tear shape, this would be placed under the follower. The follower is a piece of cardboard which is the shape of a circle. If the cam is at the edge of the follower it will create a rotary motion which means it will go round. However, if you place the cam directly under the follower it will create a linear motion which means it will go up and down.
