<p><b>English</b></p> <p>As writers, we will first look at writing a <b>playscript</b>. We will then return to persuasive writing, focusing on <b>adverts</b>.</p> <p>Our class story and guided reading text will be: <i>Empire's End: A Roman Story</i> by Leila Rasheed.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>As mathematicians, we will continue to follow the White Rose Scheme of work.</p> <p>We will be looking at <b>statistics</b> and developing our understanding of <b>geometry</b>. We will look at properties of <b>shape</b>, and <b>position and direction</b>.</p>	<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>In PE, we will be doing <b>rounders</b> and either <b>swimming</b> or <b>athletics</b>.</p> <p><b>Wednesday</b> will be athletics (for the class not swimming) and <b>Thursday</b> will be rounders (for both classes).</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>As computer scientists, we will be looking at <b>the internet</b>, under the strand of <i>systems and networks</i>. We will look at how computers are connected to make a network and how the internet works.</p>	<p><b>Term 6 – I am Warrior!</b></p> <p>In this topic, our focus will be on the Romans.</p> 	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>As Scientists we will be learning about <b>electricity</b>. We will look at what is needed to create a simple circuit, the differences between mains and battery power, before investigating different conductors and insulators.</p>
<p><b>Art and DT</b></p> <p>As designers, we will be designing and making a model that incorporates an electrical circuit to light it up.</p> <p>As artists, we will be continuing to work on our <b>drawing</b> skills, as well as studying Antony Gormley and <b>sculptures</b>.</p>		<p><b>History</b></p> <p>As historians, we will be learning about the Romans and the Celts. We will learn about the Roman Empire, the invasion of Britain, and compare the two cultures. We will also develop our understanding of key individuals, chronology and how this historical period fits in with others that we have studied (such as the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings).</p>
<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>In PSHE this term, our unit is called <b>Changing Me</b>.</p>	<p><b>Religious Education</b></p> <p><b>Does prayer change things?</b></p> <p>We will look at different types of prayer, look at some stories and experiences of prayer, in different religions, before reflecting on the unit's main question.</p>	<p><b>French</b></p> <p>In French, we will continue to learn about <b>food</b>, before finishing the year with a look at <b>France and Paris</b>.</p>
